
ORDER RESTRICTING USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES

EFFECTIVE January 3, 2012, the possession of cellular phones and other electronic recording and wireless communication devices will be prohibited in the Court Room of the Charlottesville Circuit Court while court is in session. This prohibition will not apply to licensed attorneys and their staff provided the devices remain de-activated until activation is approved by the Court. Use of audio-visual equipment for selected cases will be permitted upon advance approval by the Court.


Violation of this prohibition may result in the seizure and confiscation of the device in question and a finding of contempt, with attendant punitive sanctions imposed where appropriate upon the offending party.

The Clerk is directed to mail a true copy of this Order to the President of the Charlottesville-Albemarle Bar Association and to post a copy prominently on the front door of the Court House and the public entrance to the Court Room inside the Court House.


